Training:

Seeking Safety is a copyrighted, manualized evidence-based practice for the treatment of trauma and/or substance abuse. The manual was published in 2002 by Guilford Press, which owns the Seeking Safety book copyright. Guilford Press has given permission to the developer Dr. Lisa Najavits and her consulting organization Treatment Innovations to conduct proprietary trainings to professionals on the model to teach the model, and ensure fidelity, quality assurance and consistency.

Dr. Najavits supervises and oversees several national trainers who operate under her direct instruction. The only trainers trained by her to conduct Seeking Safety training are listed on the Seeking Safety website (<http://www.seekingsafety.org/3-03-06/subpgs/associates-bios-2-08.html>). Only trainings conducted by Dr. Najavits or her associates can be considered model-adherence and consistent in information and approach with the model.
